Founder

The organization was founded in the year of 2007, by a group of students. JAAGO Foundation focuses on issues such as illiteracy, malnutrition (especially in children) and on rehabilitating their families to better living environments and social conditions. JAAGO Foundation has two principle programs – JAAGO School and Youth Program.

JAAGO School:

With the resources at hand, the group started the first Free-of- Cost quality education system for the children from underprivileged families, in the country. The first branch of JAAGO Foundation schools is situated in the slum of Rayer Bazar. After 9 years of operation, the school now has an approximate of 2500 children receiving quality education in 13 different branches in the country. The students at JAAGO Foundation, besides receiving the literal education also part-take in activities such as drama, art, music, dance, etc. The children have also been participating in national events and come on television as well. Alongside literacy programs, in order to ensure a holistic development of the underprivileged communities, the organization have programs like Adult Literacy, English Development, Hospitality Training, Computing Skills, etc. The organization's long term goal is to open one school in each of the 64 districts of Bangladesh and serve the nation.

Youth Development Program:

Also known as Volunteer for Bangladesh. JAAGO Foundation has been the pioneer in providing the youth of Bangladesh a voice and platform. At present with more than 25000 registered volunteers throughout the country, VBD is actively working for the nation in 32 districts of Bangladesh in various national social awareness campaigns like Universal Children's Day, World Water Day, World Environment Day, Great Kindness Challenge etc.
