<p>Status of past & present interventions</p>	<p>Status of past intervention: According to baseline survey urban slum community people faced different types of problems. The situations of access to health especially reproductive health, education, safe-water supply, sanitation and waste management was very much limited. As a result of deprivation of social services and lack of knowledge community person doesn't demand their rights from service provider. A child doesn't join any education and creative activities. Women are responsible to manage family with limited resource, but their contribution is not recognized by their husbands. Women earn money, but they do not have access to that. They were used to hand over their earnings to their husbands. As a result, they do not have any control over resource that leads to disempowerment. Women are not part of decision-making process; even they do not make decision regarding their reproductive health and hygiene issue. Women Rights' was an ignored issue in this community. Youth were demoralized and doesn't take any initiatives for their community. Total population of two working area is 140,000 in seven slams. More than twenty thousand marginalized people lives in this slam.</p> <p>Status of present intervention: Considering the situation BITA is implementing EWASC project in 2 working area at 9 No Uttar pahartoli and 29 no. maderbari ward supported by Actionaid Bangladesh with a view to alleviating poverty, strengthening child rights, preventing and eliminating early marriage and reducing the number and proportion of children out of school among the families in the slum areas. Now community people aware of their rights and take initiatives to eliminate all kinds of hazards.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community people take basic services from ward office. • Ensured quality education for children • Now city corporation is functional to collect • Women are involving with alternative livelihood • Increased community knowledge on basic health, hygiene and nutrition practices • Youth leadership take initiatives to Reduce early marriage
